Welcome Junior Leaders

GUIDELINES AND EXPECTATIONS:

- Consistent participation in Eastside's eKids on your assigned days.
- Advanced notification to eKids leadership prior to any absences (by student or parent).
- Willingness to help the adult staff with the children's needs.
- Openness to follow direction given by the adult staff.
- Active participation with the children during the gathering time.
- Timely arrival to assigned class 15 minutes prior to the gathering time.
- On going participation in the Volunteer Training (when one is scheduled).
- Have an attitude that reflects a servant's heart.
- Participation in clean-up at the end of the gathering.
- Commitment to stay for the entire service and to check with the ministry leader before leaving at the end of the gathering.
- Participate during Bible Stories and singing times by:
 - o Help guide the kids with motions.
 - o Encourage participation, leading by example.
 - o Assisting with crafts and games.
- Help the kids at snack time by:
 - o Washing your own hands first before handling any food, or water.
 - o Distributing snack in the way the adult leader requests.
- Assist with clean up and dismissal before the gathering time ends by:
 - o Putting away toys, puzzles, books and any other supplies.
 - o Helping children exit with proper belongings.
 - Assist children to the room door when called by the Teacher. (Only Teachers return kids to their parents).
- Undistracted attention no cell phone usage or talking with peers.

Remember that you are setting an example and the kids will be looking to you as their role model. We want you to always be seen as appropriately and modestly dressed. Your goal is for the children to see Jesus and not you!
